Upon successful completion of all assessment requirements, candidates will be issued a Statement of Attainment for the following units:

- SISCAQU020 Perform basic water rescues
- SISCAQU023 Plan swimming lessons
- SISCAQU024 Teach water familiarisation, buoyancy and mobility skills.
- SISCAQU025 Teach water safety and survival skills.
- SISCAQU026 Teach swimming strokes.
- Option to complete the additional **AUSTSWIM Teacher of Infant and Preschool Aquatics course**. Upon successful completion of all assessment requirements, candidates will be issued a Statement of Attainment for the following units:
 - SISCAQU027 Promote the development of infants and toddlers in an aquatic environment.

ADDITIONAL TRAINING PROVIDED

- Assistance to get a Blue Card (working with children). (AQIA)
- Undertake CPR training. (Outsourced)

WHAT'S ON OFFER?

- Opportunity to gain on-the-job training from a predetermined list of swim schools.
- Once you've been accredited – you have the ability to source work as a swim teacher after school, on weekends and during school holidays.
- All training is nationally accredited training delivered by a Registered Training Organisation (RTO code - 104975).
